## Camper's Code of Conduct

So that everything is safe and enjoy themselves all campers are expected to abide by the rules for the duration of the camp:

- All campers are to participate in all activities which include daily services and Bible studies.
- All campers are required to follow instructions of the leaders, officers and activity organisers.
- No camper is to enter the room of the opposite sex.
- Any camper who wilfully damages property belonging to another will pay for its repair/ replacement.
- Alcohol/smoking is not permitted.
- The use of personal audio equipment is not permitted.

Any deliberate and/or consistent refusal to abide by the code of conduct may lead to expulsion from camp without any refund of fees.

## Who runs the camp?

Newtown Evangelical Church and other churches around Wales have run the Easter Camp since 2006, to mirror the decades of successful camps run in the summer. All staff are Christian volunteers who are interviewed and DBS checked. All staff are trained in child protection and follow the church safeguarding policy (available on request). You may know them as your local Youth Club leader. Every camp also includes trained first aider to ensure your child is safe.
